

VISION THERAPY AGREEMENT

Your child is about to embark on an exciting program which will result in many benefits to your family. The process of vision therapy will facilitate many dynamic changes from more comfortable vision to increased abilities to learn. A close, personal relationship develops between the therapists and the patients. Your child's success is our success.

We believe it is important in our relationship to have a clear understanding of your and our responsibilities in entering into this agreement. Please read the following information about our office procedures and policies and discuss any questions you have with a member of our staff.

PAYMENT OF THERAPY FEES IS DUE AT THE TIME OF SERVICES RENDERED unless other arrangements have been made in advance.

STAFFING

Eye Q Vision Therapy Center has a staff of qualified therapists. Your child may be working with one or all of the therapists at one point or another. There is no guarantee that your child will be working with only one therapist throughout the entire program.

MISSED APPOINTMENTS

Continuity of weekly appointments is an essential factor in your child's progress and maximum benefits. When you know in advance that you must miss a session (for school activities, special events, vacations, etc.) and you give us one week or more notice, we can reschedule the appointment. If you (or your child) are ill, call our office as ahead of your scheduled time as possible to arrange for a make-up appointment. Excessive missed appointments are cause for loss of your preferred appointment time and possible suspension of therapy.

Therapy time is reserved specifically for your child. Our office schedule and staffing are planned accordingly. Missed appointments without prior notice will be charged a fee of \$35.

INSTRUCTIONS TO PARENTS

Please arrange your time so that you will be able to be present in the waiting room for the entire first session. After the first session if you wish to run an errand, get a cup of coffee, etc. you may, but we do ask that you return before the end of your child's session. Parents are more than welcome to wait in the waiting area during scheduled sessions.

Please make sure your child comes to therapy with their glasses needed for each session.
